

Parts for Empty Container Handler

Empty Container Handler Part - An extremely vital part of the entire terminal operation is effectively handling the empty containers. For various drivers, there might be less of a time factor in handling empty containers, while for others; this training will be an introduction into this type of working environment. The empty container handler course is a post training chance designed for tractor and forklift truck drivers.

Many important areas are included in this week-long training course. It is designed to be conducted on location utilizing local apparatus. The content of the course includes, naming and recognizing the function of different components of the apparatus, function and naming of various instruments seen on the empty container handler, and understanding whichever irregularities found on some parts of an empty container handler.

The course also teaches the operator how to effectively execute a pre-inspection. There is some focus on determining the most ergonomically correct and comfortable working position. Familiarity of various crane types is covered together with understanding of different kinds of chassis. Important topics like the working procedures on a container terminal are also talked about, along with understanding of logistical procedures in that situation.

Safety communications like for instance hand signals and all other current safety regulations are covered. Lastly, the course will teach the operator how to successfully complete an end inspection of an empty container handler.
